Cancellation Policy: Tellington TTouch Training reserves the right to cancel a session if necessary because of circumstances beyond our control or when enrollment is deemed insufficient. In this case all payments you have made will be refunded – whether deposit only or full tuition amount.

Participant Cancellation Policy: For cancellations made more than 30 days in advance of the training, a refund will be given minus a \$100.00 administrative fee. No refunds are given for cancellations made less than 30 days prior to the start of the training, but you may apply this money to another training that must be attended within one year of your cancellation date.

Animals attending the Training: Because this class will be held at the Austin Animal Shelter, we request that you leave your own companions at home. The focus will be on working with the shelter animals - dogs, cats, possibly rabbits and others.

Materials and Suggested Equipment:

Please bring your record of trainings and your original three-ring binder as the class may at times refer back to earlier materials and you may be given additional handouts. And if you are able to transport it, please bring your TTouch equipment such as harnesses, leads, wraps, etc. Be sure to mark your own equipment.

What to Wear: Comfortable clothing for bending, stretching, occasionally sitting on the floor. And please note, since the class is being held at a shelter, close-toe shoes are required.

Meals: Meals are not included in the tuition. Water, coffee, tea, and light snacks are provided. There is a one-hour break each day for lunch. There are few restaurants near the training venue, but there are options for ordering lunches for delivery or pick-up.

If you are traveling to the class:

Airport: Austin-Bergstrom International Airport (AUS)

Accommodations: The Austin Animal Center is located only 4 miles north of the airport and there are numerous hotels in the area to choose from. The following listed are only a few suggestions.
