Tuition:

Introductory price of **\$750.00** if this is your first training; **\$900.00** if you are continuing in the program and this is your second through sixth session.

A **\$300.00** deposit is due at the time of registration to hold a space in either the class. The balance is due October 11. Or pay in full by September 29 and receive the early-bird discount of \$50.00 off the tuition!

Please note, if you pay your deposit with a credit card, any balance due will automatically be charged to the same card thirty days before the class start unless you have already paid the tuition in full, or let us know that you wish to use a different method of payment.

Cancellation Policy: Tellington TTouch Training reserves the right to cancel a session if necessary because of circumstances beyond our control or when enrollment is deemed insufficient. In this case all payments you have made will be refunded – whether deposit only or full tuition amount.

Participant Cancellation Policy: For cancellations made more than 30 days in advance of the training, a refund will be given minus a \$100.00 administrative fee. No refunds are given for cancellations made less than 30 days prior to the start of the training, but you may apply this money to another training that must be attended within one year of your cancellation date.

Animals attending the Training: Because this class will be held at the Austin Animal Shelter, the focus will be on working with the shelter animals - dogs, cats, possibly rabbits and others! Please leave your own companions at home.

This venue, and the chance to work with such a variety of animals, offers an usual opportunity to see how the Tellington Method can evoke a sense of well-being, and calm, focused learning and listening

At this class with Linda, participants will work in pairs and have a chance to work throughout the week with the same dogs. There is a large outdoor space for practicing "The Playground for Higher Learning" ground exercises. And of course, there will be the Tellington TTouch bodywork to teach developmental, emotional and physical balance. Body wraps and the Freedom Leash with Robyn's special sliding handle often have a miraculous effect of overcoming pulling on the leash. This is an opportunity to see and effect many changes in behavior and relationship with the dogs. For those interested in working with cats, the Austin Animal Care Center also offers an ideal venue.

You will be given a binder with training handouts at your first class. You may wish to bring your own notebook as well for taking notes. If you are returning for your 2nd or other continuing session, please bring your original 3-ring binder to class.

What to Wear: Comfortable clothing for bending, stretching, occasionally sitting on the floor. **And please note, since the class is being held at a shelter, close-toe shoes are required.**

Meals: There are few restaurants near the training venue, but there are options for ordering lunches for delivery or pick-up.
